

acob began to receive early intervention services J at 24 months old. He was not talking or babbling at his age and would get easily frustrated during play. The mother had great concerns about Jacob's speech and language development. During 2021, Jacob started to imitate sound, words and phrases of songs gradually. He enjoyed the interactions with his Early Interventionist and parents during the sessions. Sometimes he would cry when the session was over. His language and attention span has improved so much that he can participate in story telling when reading a book with his parents now. His parents were also getting confident at handling his behaviors by using positive disciplines. Jacob is now a non-stop talker according to his parents. His mother has expressed her appreciation to LSF's
