**T**his year, we had a very special letter written by a staff member who has been with Life Steps for years and years, through many journeys in life. She wanted to share a word for the special event, Lobster Feed. Here is an excerpt from Charlene Kang's speech that evening:

"If someone returns to the same job three times, either the place is special—or the person is a little crazy. In my case, I think it's both.

My name is Charlene Kang. I started with Life Steps in 1996 as the first Mandarin-speaking early interventionist. Working with medically fragile infants, toddlers with complex needs, and families in chaotic situations taught me something important—early intervention isn't magic. It doesn't cure; it supports. It helps children and families find comfort, connection, and possibility where things once felt impossible.

Those early years shaped who I am. I left Life Steps twice due to personal and family changes, but after 17 years away, I came back in September 2024—because this isn't just a job for me. Life Steps is a mission, a community, and a calling.

For over 40 years, Life Steps staff have walked alongside children, adults with disabilities, and older adults—helping them build skills, confidence, and independence. A lot has changed over the years, but our heart has not: we still serve with excellence, compassion, and respect.
