LSF SCAS: Seaside Leaning Center Re-Opens

ugust 2, 2021 was a long-anticipated day for Seaside Learning Center and its members as this is the day we re-opened and resumed in-person activities at a limited capacity. The Center developed a plan for re-engagement that included strict safety protocols and intensive training for both staff and participants before opening. We're slowly increasing the number of members per week. The Center was temporarily closed starting March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Through the Zoom platform, we were able to continue our services virtually. This was an invaluable resource to our members as it allowed them to interact and check on each other's wellbeing. The Center also provided deliveries of PPE, art & craft items, small gifts, and offered individual phone calls to members unable to join the Zoom activities. Currently, the Center offers two sessions: mornings from 8:30AM to 12:00PM and afternoons from 1:00PM to 4:30PM. In-person activities offer members a better way to connect with each other in a safe way. These activities bring

our members joy, which is reflected on their faces and in their attitudes.

SF Children and Family Service in Southern California is proud to announce our new program "Happy Campers Children's Center." Our new location is a preschool and a day care center serving the Baldwin Park community.

Happy Campers Children's Center's philosophy is to provide adequate childcare services based on the needs of the child, family, and community and strive for excellence in our abilities to meet those needs. Our program consists of a balanced schedule of daily activities providing opportunities for the individual development of the child's self-image, self-control and independence; expression through creativity; social skills through group activities; intellect through a balance of teacher directed activities and individual exploration; thoughtful and courteous behavior; gross/fine motor skills; good health and hygiene habits; respect for others and property.

Our program welcomes any child six weeks old through five years of age. Our office operates from 7:00am - 5:30 pm Monday through Friday. Our future goal is to develop an inclusive classroom within our program so we can serve









children with special needs as well as children from the community.

LSF Children and Family Services: Participant Spotlight

Simon is a sweet little boy who happily participates in play. He was referred to Life Steps Foundation for Early Intervention at 13 months of age due to concerns about his gross motor, and speech and language development. Simon initially presented delays in his overall development. He was a quiet little boy who did not always respond to voices in his environment. He also had difficulty communicating his needs at home. Simon usually preferred to sit in one spot for extended periods of time without much movement. After receiving early intervention services, Simon was able to increase his vocabulary and is now starting to use it to communicate his needs. He can run, jump, and walk with good balance and coordination. He is also able to write the letters of the alphabet as well as his name. His mother has expressed that Simon is beginning to understand simple directions and is now beginning to pay attention to changes and people in his environment. It was a pleasure working with Simon and his family. I have no doubt that Simon's family will continue to support him in his development and will be instrumental in his future success.
