Eligible participants must meet the following criteria as defined by the Older Americans Act:

- Seniors age 60 and over.
- Seniors who reside in Santa Barbara County (Santa Maria Valley and close surrounding areas) or San Luis Obispo County.
- Seniors not currently receiving duplicate services by another agency such as In Home Support Services (IHSS).
